IWK provides free prenatal education in Nova Scotia with SmartParent

The Challenge

Nova Scotia was looking for a way to provide critically needed prenatal education to its population, in a way that is accessible, inclusive, and reliable.

The Solution

The IWK team and Nova Scotia Public Health chose text messaging as a solution to quickly introduce information to parents that was evidence-based and available to everyone. Pregnant people now have prenatal education sent directly to their phones. Sign-up for Nova Scotians is quick and easy through texting "Baby" to 12323 or visiting <u>www.smartparent.ca</u>. Messages arrive three times weekly to guide parents, each with embedded links to online resources. IWK has added links to local Nova Scotia resources to customize the program to their users.

The Launch

The program has been promoted by primary care physicians, nurses, and midwives, many of whom tried out the program themselves. With a strong social media presence, IWK promoted the program through Facebook and Instagram. IWK set the ambitious goal of 600 users by 3 months.

Nova Scotia Responds

Enrollment targets were met and exceeded. Over 800 parents enrolled by month three. The long-term goal is 2400 participants or 30% of the childbearing population by one year.
